Since 1947 the first week in May has held a special significance for Jewish women in the UK and Ireland. The Jewish Women's Week (JWW) Campaign is still the only Home Office authorised door-to-door collection in the Jewish community and is supported by all the major UK Synagogue organisations. It is organised entirely by volunteers calling on as many Jewish homes as they can reach. The Coronavirus and nationwide lockdown means that Jewish Women's Week will be unable to take place in May. However we are ever hopeful that our army of ladies will be up and running in June or July.

Sadly now more than ever, WIZO (or JWW) needs your help to ensure we are able to continue to support real needs at this critical time. These include our day care centres in the hospitals - the only place medical staff and key workers are able to leave their children; a food campaign ensuring children at risk who depend on WIZO centres which have had to close, still receive their only hot meal of the day and victims of abuse who cannot go to a shelter, but need to be 'rescued'.
