The first Jews settled in Golders Green just before the First World War, and by 1930 the suburb was recognised for having a significant Jewish community. By 1960, the Jewish population of Golders Green had tripled. Today, a century after the arrival of the first Jewish families, the community remains very diverse and continues to grow. Golders Green is now the most Jewishly populous neighbourhood in the country. Despite its prominence and its vibrancy, until recently Jews of Golders Green have not been the subject of a detailed historical study. Pam's book, *The History of the Jewish Community of Golders Green*, which was published in 2016, addressed this oversight, filling an important gap in Anglo-Jewish history. Based largely on people's memories, the book is filled with wonderful anecdotes, which Pam will be sharing with us when she gives her talk.
